- Business ethics


TECHIIA's Sustainable Development Goals

We now adhere to five Sustainable Development Goals:
















The Face Of Kindness

The NGO Techiia Foundation is a public organization for the implementation of charitable projects and social initiatives of the holding. It saves lives and makes them better for those who are in need

The main KPI of the NGO Techiia Foundation is the maximum benefit to the largest number of people.

Since the beginning of 2018, the founders of the NGO Techiia Foundation Oleg Krot and Yura Lazebnikov have invested over UAH 15 million in social projects.

Healthcare

Our goal is to prevent children in Ukraine from dying of cancer. That is why we provide hospitals with medical equipment and finance the Eva Inclusion and Rehabilitation Center.

Development of STEM education

We support university- and student education initiatives. We partner with the Ivan Franko National University of Lviv and the student organization BEST.

Direct assistance

Life goes with the flow. Life is calm and turbulent. We support people with direct assistance.

The 'Get Well Soon' project

Children in Ukraine should not die of cancer

This is the **global goal** of the project, which we are taking small but effective steps towards. We help one and one rehabilitation center to show by their examples that Ukraine's health care system can be modern, efficient and effective.

During the 2020 pandemic the 'Get Well Soon!' project aimed at an **additional goal** that is not only to benefit medical institutions and their patients, but also the holding team. It helped unite the team and strengthen internal communications during remote work.

The beginning

In 2019 the NGO Techiia Foundation has started public cooperation with the children's hospital in Kropyvnytskyi.

Later on, holding employees learned about charitable initiatives thanks to reports in internal channels, <u>publications</u> in the media, and <u>stories</u> on TV.

In 2020 TECHIIA employees decided to join the charitable initiatives. And the start of the pandemic as well as the transition to remote work increased the need for colleagues to communicate with each other beyond work.





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TECHIIA

'Get Well Soon!' is a project that unites the employees and founders of TECHIIA around the CSR goal – the fight against childhood cancer.

The project is complex and consists of three parts:

Helping hospitals

we investigate hospitals and their needs to provide them with modern equipment

Equipping the EVA center

we finance and help the organizationally unique center of inclusion and correction

Cooperating with the Tabletochki Foundation

we join initiatives that involve as many employees as possible





How it works

The NGO Techiia Foundation does not have a staff responsible for the project. But in addition to their work tasks, employees of various holding companies are willing to join charitable initiatives. An algorithm for implementing a typical project of purchasing the equipment for hospitals:

- TECHIIA's founders learn about the need for help from a medical institution or partner foundations.
- The team of the tender department helps to select and purchase the best options of equipment.
- Legal officers work on the purchase process and transfer agreements to protect the hospital from fraud and to ensure that the equipment is used as intended.
- The PR team prepares internal communication to engage employees in fundraising, and external communication to broadcast TECHIIA values to the media.

Following this algorithm, as of the beginning of 2021, the NGO Techiia Foundation provided the hospital in Kropyvnytskyi with more than UAH 8 million worth of help. Our joint work saves more than 100 children every year.










The algorithm of interaction with the Eva Inclusion and Correction Center is different. It is based on the children's pool rehabilitation project by the NGO Techiia Foundation and became a full-fledged center with its own premises and staff – doctors, rehabilitators and psychologists.

About EVA

The center helps children who have undergone oncology treatment to return to normal life as well as also provide assistance to children with such disabilities as:

- Cerebral palsy of various forms
- Down syndrome
- PAC
- childhood autism
- mental disorders
- speech delay
- hearing loss
- musculoskeletal disorders






Motivated by the stories of children who were able to walk after rehabilitation, TECHIIA design and communication teams actively joined the project.

- The PR department helps the Center with communication so that as many children as possible can use the free correction and rehabilitation services here.

Cooperation with Tabletochki Charitable Foundation

The third part of the project is joint initiatives with the Tabletochki Foundation. Our goal resonates – we work to ensure that children in Ukraine do not die of cancer.

The NGO Techiia Foundation has transferred funds to purchase medicines, and during the New Year holidays, we launched a joint charity store, where TECHIIA employees donated more than UAH 35,000.

How we engage employees

The main tool is the **internal communication channels** in <u>Slack Messenger</u>. We talk about the positive results of joint projects and of those who need our help.

External communications are no less important. We cover every equipment-related project and Eva Center news in our own TECHIIA media, as well as national and regional media.

Engagement indicators

As of the beginning of 2021, the NGO Techiia Foundation has implemented charitable projects worth **almost UAH 11 million**, and more than **120 TECHIIA employees** have been engaged in these initiatives financially or non-financially. For example, designers, communicators, financial and legal officers took part in the projects as specialists.
